The University of Torino and the Collegio Carlo Alberto are pleased to invite you to attend the 14th PhD Workshop in Economics. In light of the current Covid-19 situation, the Workshop will be held in a hybrid mode, both online and in person.

For this year's edition, we are pleased to announce the participation of Professor Enrico Rettore (University of Padova), Dr. Sylke Viola Schnepf (Joint Research Centre JRC) and Professor Ekaterina Zhuravskaya (Paris School of Economics) as Keynote Lecturers. We invite you to submit your paper, which can be either completed or a work in progress. Extended abstract (up to 500 words) will also be considered. All areas of Economics (either theoretical or empirical) will be taken into consideration. In presence participation is strongly encouraged, whenever possible, and extra points will be awarded to applicants who commit to attend in person. Please note that, in accordance with the Italian Government Decree n. 111, issued on August 6, 2021, all visitors to the Collegio's premises must be in possession of a valid EU Digital Covid Certificate (Green Pass).

Submission

Please send your paper and CV through the Apply Section of the website (https://www.workshopecon.carloalberto.org/apply/). Papers must be written and presented in English. The session format will include a 25 minutes presentation by the author, 10 minutes of discussion by a formal discussant and 5 minutes of general discussion.
